



REMUNERATION REPORTING REQUIREMENT CEFC 2017-18

The Secretary for the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet has requested that all Commonwealth entities provide greater transparency of remuneration paid to senior executives and highly paid officials. As such, each Commonwealth entity has been asked to publish relevant information relating to the remuneration of all executives and other highly paid staff each financial year on its website, using a standard reporting format.
