

SENATE ORDER FOR ENTITY CONTRACTS LISTING RELATING TO THE PERIOD 1 JULY 2018 – 31 DECEMBER 2018

Pursuant to the Senate Order for entity contracts the following table sets out contracts entered into by the Clean Energy Finance Corporation which provide for a consideration to the value of \$100,000 or more (GST inclusive) and which:

- a. which have been entered into prior to or during the period 1 July 2018 31 December 2018; and
- b. have not been fully performed as at 31 December 2018.

Most of the contracts listed contain confidentiality provisions of a general nature that are designed to protect the confidential information of the parties that may be obtained or generated in carrying out the contract.

The reasons for including such clauses include:

a. ordinary commercial prudence that requires protection of commercial-sensitive contracts, information, trade secrets, proprietary information and the like; and/or b. protection of other material and personal information.
